Persecuted Church: Tanzania -Though the Tanzanian government generally seeks to protect Christians from persecution, they still face significant opposition in Muslim-majority areas along the coast and in western regions. Tanzania is also home to many unreached tribal groups who are resistant to the gospel. Like many countries in Africa, Tanzania is being targeted by Muslim groups outside the country that work to Islamize Tanzania by establishing Muslim businesses and schools. helping Muslims get elected to office and passing laws that favor Islam. Even so, local churches in Tanzania boldly work to spread the gospel.

- Pray for Generosa, who sometimes sees the men believed to be her husband's killers.
- Pray that Tanzanian missionaries will share the gospel with unreached people groups on the Swahili Coast.
- Pray for a strong Christian witness in the archipelago of Zanzibar, which is 99% Muslim.
- Pray for Bible translation work in languages spoken by the last remaining unreached people groups.
- Pray that Christians living in remote, predominantly Muslim areas will have access to God's Word.
