Persecuted Church: Tajikistan - Most churches in Tajikistan have been forced to meet covertly for more than a decade, following the revocation of their registration. Economic hardship in the nation has forced many pastors and church leaders to seek work in Russia to support their families. Tajikistan lacks basic infrastructure, and its difficulties are compounded by corruption and the opium trade. The country has experienced an influx of refugees from Afghanistan and has the Taliban at its border. New Christian converts receive the harshest treatment. Believers are sometimes beaten and abused, and they are frequently summoned for questioning by the secret police. It is illegal to teach children about Christ.

- Pray for Christian converts who suffer persecution from family members or the secret police.
- Pray that Christians will boldly share the gospel with Tajik children, even though it is prohibited by law.
- Using Isaiah 52:7 as a guide, thank God for ministry work among people living in remote mountain regions.
- Pray for the courage, protection and perseverance of those working to translate the Bible into local languages.
- Bibles are available only in some Tajik cities. Pray that every Tajik believer will own a copy of God's Word.
