



Persecuted Church: Yemen -

For many years, the people of Yemen have suffered from civil wars and violence from Islamic extremists. Although the situation has further deteriorated since the start of the most recent civil war, the gospel has flourished and many Yemeni Muslims have come to know Christ. Yemeni Christians have become bolder in their outreach efforts, though it is still extremely dangerous to even be identified as a Christian. They must reach out in creative ways that are both bold and wise. Small but steady numbers of Yemenis are continually being added to the body of Christ, and more are gaining interest as the influence of Christian media grows. Most regions of the country include at least one follower of Christ. Christians in Yemen account for only a small fraction of 1 percent of the population. persecution.com

- Pray for Yemeni Christians who face food shortages and economic hardships amid the region's political unrest.
- Pray that Bibles stolen in an attack on a church will touch the hearts of those who do not yet know Christ.
- Pray that media outreach ministries will make God's Word increasingly accessible.
- Pray that God will supply the needs of Christian converts who have lost jobs.
